



Lesson Outline for a “PeaceKeeper” small group session

- **5 minutes** - Meet & Greet (pick-up refreshments if available)
- **3 minutes** - Open in a brief prayer - Pray for the meeting and bless the officers that attended, as well as those that were not able to attend. Always remember to pray for safety for the officers that are working.
- **30 - 45 minutes** - Start session - take turns reading the Bible passages and stories. Remember to strive for group participation.

NOTE - As the host leader, it is very important to encourage discussion among your group. One of the goals is to get law enforcement officers to open up in conversation. Being connected as a small group is important. We do not want officers to simply “attend” the study, but instead be active participates. In short, have a purpose to your meetings. Do not simply make it a “Christian Cop Social” hour. Instead, give your meeting a spiritual purpose. God will bless and honor your group as you expand your territory for His benefit.

Remember - “We serve better, when we work together”

- **10 minutes** - Close in prayer. Pray for any prayer concerns. Make a list of your “Small Group Most Wanted”. These would be other LEO’s that you may want to pray for, or ask to join your small group.

Remember to thank everyone for attending and encourage them to return next week and bring a friend or co-worker
